



## Peas

The two main types of peas we get in stock are Garden or English and sugar snaps.

English, green, or garden peas are bright green, bulging pods are tough and inedible. The peas need to be shelled. The peas can be very sweet and should be eaten soon after harvest.

Sugar snap and snow peas are both types of sugar peas. With both, you can eat the pods. Sugar snap peas are curved and plump with sweet peas inside. Snow peas are wide and flat pods that have immature sweet peas. They have a very crunchy pod. It is very popular in Asian dishes. Both can be eaten raw or cooked. Most important don't overcook them.

Peas like a soil that retains moisture yet drains well. Plants need little fertilizer - one application of 5 - 10 - 10 will suffice. Provide support for climbing peas and do pick often or plant might stop producing.
